#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 350.3 - PERSONAL MOBILE DEVICES AND SOCIAL MEDIA IN SCHOOLS

Work to develop the Administrative Procedure to support the Ministerial Order on the use of personal mobile devices and social media continues. A draft Administrative Procedure has been developed based on work this fall with school administrators and will be reviewed again by administrators at the October 23<sup>rd</sup> All Administrator Meeting. The Administrative Procedure will be reviewed by the Student Advisory Committee on Friday, October 25, and will then be taken to School Councils for discussion when it is complete.

#### ANNUAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES HOLIDAY CARD ART CONTEST

The Trustee's Annual Holiday Card Art Contest is underway! This year's theme is *All is Bright* and Division high school students have been asked to unleash their creativity for a chance to have their artwork chosen as the cover of the annual Holiday card. ### MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS STATUTES AMENDMENT ACT (BILL 20)

Trustees reviewed the potential impact of Bill 20, intended by the United Conservative Party government to strengthen local elections and councils, on School Trustee Elections. The Act will be debated soon in the Legislature and is scheduled to come into effect October 31. Upon the Act being proclaimed by the Government, the Board will follow up at a future meeting to discuss the need for new Board Bylaws relating to the potential requirement for candidates for school board trustees to submit a criminal record check and/or a deposit with their nomination papers in future elections.
